Fun Facts about the Arctic

- The Arctic is located at the northernmost part of our planet. Scientists usually define the Arctic as the area above the 'Arctic Circle' — an imaginary line that circles around the top of the globe.
- The ice of the Arctic contains around ten percent of the world's fresh water. This giant, white, frozen reservoir reflects sunlight, helping keep the region cool. It also plays a super-important role in keeping our global climate stable.

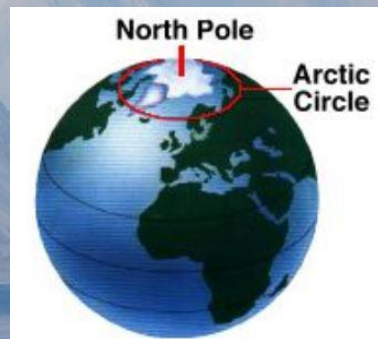
Map of the Arctic

Vocabulary

Globe - a ball shaped object with a map of the world on it.

Continent - a large area of land that consists of several countries

City - a large town

Arctic Circle - an imaginary line drawn around the northern part of the world
Weather - the conditions outside at a particular time

Season - the main periods a year can be divided into which have typical weather conditions

Climate - the general weather conditions that are typical of a place

Tundra - a large flat area of land where the ground below the top layer of soil is always frozen

Adapted - when something is made suitable for its purpose

Camouflage - the way something is coloured and shaped so it cannot be easily seen in its natural environment
