Continent	The divisions of land on Earth
Habitat	The place where a plant or animal lives.
Ocean	The whole body of salt water that covers almost $\frac{3}{4}$ of Earth.
Mammal	Warm blooded vertebrates
Reptile	Cold Blooded vertebrates which usually have scales.
Amphibian	An organism that can live on land or water.
Fish	An animal that lives and breathe in water.
Bird	Warm blooded animal that has feathers and lays eggs,
Endangered	A plant or animal that is in danger of disappearing forever
Extinct	A species that has died out completely.
