Key Vocabulary

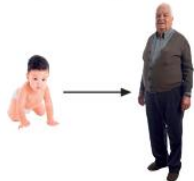
Adolescent, baby, foetus, elderly adult, adult, lifestyle, milestone, baby, toddler, child, womb, period, reproduce, puberty, hormone, life

Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. (Y2 - Animals, including humans)

gestation – the period of time that a foetus develops in its mother's womb



lifespan – the period of time that an animal is alive



Pupils should be taught to:

Describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

Reproduction in humans (as an example of a mammal), including the structure and function of the male and female reproductive systems, menstrual cycle (without details of hormones),

womb – the organ in mammals in which a baby develops



foetus – an unborn baby growing inside the mother's womb



gestation – the period of time that a foetus develops in its mother's womb



mammal – an animal with a spine and with fur or hair on its body, which gives birth to live young and feeds its young on milk



offspring – the young of a living thing



milestone – a significant event in a person's life



baby – from birth to around 1 year old



toddler – a young child who is between 1 and 3



child – a young human below the age of puberty



womb – the organ in mammals in which a baby develops
