PE

We have PE lessons every Monday and Wednesday. Children please come to school in their PE kit, with their school shoes on, on these two days. They can wear their school shoes in class and then just change their footwear when they do PE. PE kit should contain a plain round-neck & short-sleeve PE shirt, a track suit and a pair of Velcro trainers kept at school. Spare socks are advisable. A spare PE kit should be kept in school every day in case we may have additional sessions or children forget to come in their PE kit. This should be kept in a drawstring bag or very small rucksack style bag only. No other bags will be permitted. **No Football kits.**

Reading and Spelling

Children please practise reading frequently, ideally every day. After finishing reading make sure to record it in the reading record.

We have guided reading sessions and spelling lessons every day.

Phonics/Grammars

During the Autumn term Y2 pupils will also have their statutory phonic assessment. They will be having daily phonic/Grammar sessions in school. Some children may still continue the phonics catch up/keep up sessions three times a week in Spring and Summer terms. Please ensure you complete any tasks sent home in relation to this.

Homework

Homework will be given out on Friday. Please bring homework back to school next Friday and we will mark them together.

We are no longer giving out paper versions of Maths addition & subtraction and/or tackling tables. After Christmas, children can practise their timetables on www.tacklingtables.co.uk. Your child will need to learn their 2,3, 5 and 10 x tables and corresponding division facts by the end of Y2.
