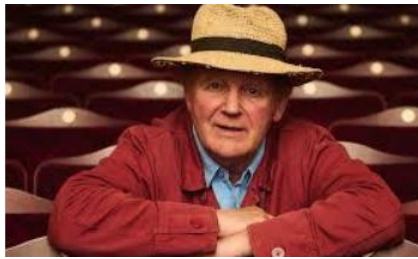


Summer 2025 Newsletter

Dear Parents and Carers,

Multiplication Tables Check

After half term, the children will sit their multiplication check. Children are expected to be able to recall their multiplication facts up to 12×12 . Please continue to help your child to recall their multiplication facts as quickly as possible. To help them learn their facts, they can use Tackling Tables, www.timestables.co.uk, chant their facts or they can make memory games to play. So that you can check their progress, they can carry out a test on U R Brainy MTC - this will give you a score and you can see their results to find which facts they found difficult. Any support with helping your child would be greatly appreciated.

Reading

Reading for pleasure is known to be beneficial for children in all areas of the curriculum. Please ensure your child brings a reading book home and you listen to them read as often as possible. They should also have a reading diary where you can record what they have read and inform us of any successes or difficulties. As I cannot see all of children's records daily, please feel free to message me on ClassDojo if there is anything you want me to know urgently. If your child has a library book which they cannot read independently, please read it to them if you are happy to. These are books the children have chosen themselves. Choosing a book is a great motivation to read.

PE

PE will still be on a Tuesday and Friday. Children can come in their PE kits on these days.

Jewellery

No jewellery please except a watch and a pair of stud earrings. Please remember we cannot help children remove or replace earrings so if these can be left at home on PE days that would be preferable.
